

Parkinson's Disease (PD) 101 Training for Community Health Workers (CHWs)/Promotores de Salud

The Parkinson's Foundation offers an interactive training, Parkinson's Disease 101: How to Talk About Parkinson's in Your Community for Community Health Workers (CHWs)/Promotores de Salud. Participants will gain basic knowledge about PD, identify available resources, and establish talking points to help deliver PD education in their community.

We offer this training in two ways:

- **Live Webinar**: A one-hour virtual session that provides an overview of Parkinson's disease.
- **In-Person Workshop**: Comprehensive training designed for a larger group setting, lasting 1.5 to 2.5 hours.

The training program features a "train the trainer" component, engaging learning activities, and pre/post assessments. The program is FREE and includes a certificate of attendance.
